Checklist for Open Space Permits:

_____ Right of Way Access Permit Required. Call Kerry Holly with the City Public Works Department: 303-335-4608. YOU must obtain a Right-of-Way permit to cross any curb from the street to access open space. Note that this is a separate application that does have a fee. Copies of both permits should be kept on the project site at all times for Code Enforcement.

_____ The homeowner or contractor must let the Open Space Division know of work to be done at least 48 hours in advance of work start (303) 335-4743.

_____ No storing or staging materials on open space.

_____ The City requires Contractors to use designated trail as they access the property. Limit damage and disturbance to one set of 2 tire tracks (pull-in and reverse in the same set of tire tracks). See map/text for approved route.

_____ Minimize impact to resources when driving off-trail. Driving open space when wet is not permitted.

_____ Stop for pedestrians on the trail and be aware of potential blind corners. Yield to all other trail traffic. Be aware that trails are multi-use and watch for bicycles approaching from behind.

_____ Limit speed to 5 mph. Use hazard lights while on the trail.

_____ Use a spotter on the ground when backing up.

_____ Watch for overhanging limbs to avoid any damage to trees.

_____ If private fence or wall is to be removed in order to complete work, the new fence must be installed one foot within private property, maintained by the private property owner and not encroach onto open space property. Fence style must be approved by the Planning Department. Public fences are not to be impacted.

_____ Note any existing damage to trail or vegetation here. Permit holder is responsible for repairing any new damage or disturbance on open space including:

_____ Trail surface – rake out tire tracks when finished

_____ Fences and any other infrastructure (e.g., signs, benches, trash cans).

_____ Vegetation and plant communities – extensive damage will require restoration actions.
