

Telework Facts: Colorado Employers

- Over half of employers have provided telework training for employees. Kudos Colorado employers!
- Only 40% of employers have provided telework training for supervisors.
- Developing a formal, written telework policy is a crucial need.
- 57% employers have developed pandemic response teams however only 26% have developed formal plans for employees returning to the workplace.
- While 20% of employers have implemented on site health screenings and 20% plan to, 35% of employers still feel they need expert help with on-site health screening.



 - DRCOG + 8 Transportation Management Associations
 - Funded through federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality dollars
 - Aims to reduce traffic congestion in the Denver region to improve air quality

 - Promoting transportation choices





How has your organization benefitted from teleworking during the COVID-19 outbreak? Open-ended question. Responses were coded.

Business continuity, continued service to customers	23%	34%	32%	34%	29%
Discovered new possibilities, and new ways of doing things. Discovered we could do it.	16%	13%	20%	14%	15%
Keep employees safe	8%	16%	10%	16%	12%
Employees more productive	6%	5%	5%	4%	5%
Stronger morale and trust bonds with employees	7%	3%		4%	5%
