

FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING

June 20 – July 15

Louisville Public Works Operations Division will begin annual water main flushing on June 20, 2022.

Testing and flushing will run on weekdays 8 AM - 4 PM through July 15.

Crews began the operation at he Southside of West South Boulder Road between Via Appia Way and Colorado 42.

Work will continue Southward to the Dutch Creek neighborhood over the next several weeks.

Signage will be placed around the areas that are being work on daily to keep residents updated with the flushing process.

What is flushing?

City utility staff has implemented <u>unidirectional flushing (UDF) guidelines</u> developed by the <u>American Water Works Association</u>, which minimize the potential of rust and sediment reaching water customers. The flushing operation scours and cleans rust and sediment from the water mains and may temporarily discolor the water in the area being flushed.

Your water The entire process will take approximately four weeks, but should only affect hours of 8 am to 4 pm (on weekdays) when crews are in the area. If your water appears rusty, running a garden hose or sprinkler system for a few minutes will normally clear it up.
