- Please come during assigned skill level times if they are designated. All
 other drop in times are open to all levels. Player rating is self-evaluated.
 Should there be a mix of players abilities take that opportunity to work
 on more advanced skills like dinks or anticipating team positioning.
 - To Rate your abilities please go to usapickleball.org/tournaments/tournament-player-ratings
 - Beginner drop is for 1.0-3.0 players
 - Intermediate drop is for 3.5 and higher players
- Four players per court. No singles games if there are players waiting.
- When <u>people</u> are waiting to play
 - 4 up, 4 down. All players vacate the court and the next four people in line get the court the first court available.
- The next players will be determined by placing paddles in a line on the south side of the courts. When you arrive or vacate the court, please place your paddle in line to get a game. Do not touch other people's paddles.
- All players should act with good sportsmanship and integrity. Players not demonstrating these values may be asked to leave without a refund.
- Have fun! Remember that everyone is here to recreate and have a good time. We encourage players of all skill levels to be welcoming of each other.
- Let's remember why Pickleball is the fastest growing sport in the country. It is because of its inclusive atmosphere where anyone can play, and great for keeping seniors social and active. Make everyone's time on the court a positive experience for you and the people you play with.
