III. Climate Education Scavenger Hunt Planning

 - QR code will be for more adult information (rebates)
 - Only making one QR code with all of the information
 - Use QR codes from the City of Louisville page with all of the other QR codes
 - QR code that leads to a bunch of different links and then tell them which link to click on
 - ii. Do we have enough concrete information to proceed?
- Finalize poster locations and the logistics of the props we may include at each spot.
 - i. Assign who will request permission from each site, as well as oversee the care and keeping of the materials there.
 - Ask RTD if a sign can be hung on their sign pole
 - Need permission from store if we want to hang a display
 - If want to have physical activities possible location at

 - Library could hand out paper to carry with them and write down the letters of the secret word

- Raymond in charge of visual for how much water the average person uses in a day

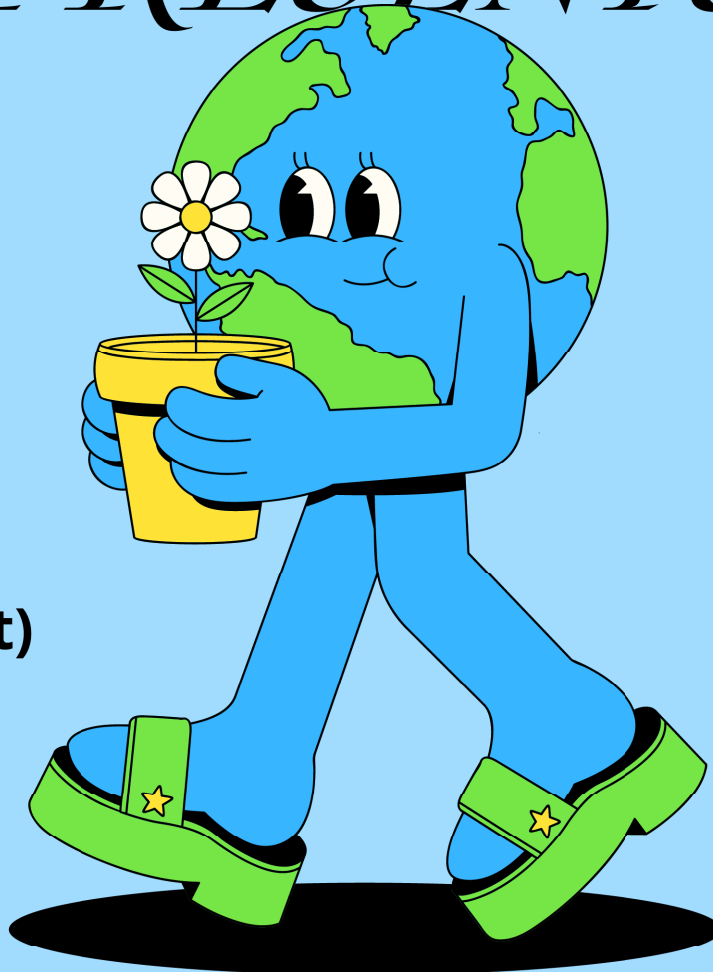
