

Industrial User Accidental Discharge Notification

Pursuant to City of Louisville Municipal Code Chapter 13.32 (Sewer Use Regulations), all Industrial Users shall be required to immediately notify the City of any discharge that could cause problems to the POTW, including any and all slug loading.

In case of an accidental discharge, it is the responsibility of the Industrial User to immediately telephone and notify the City of the incident. The notification shall include:

- Location of discharge
- Type, concentration & volume of waste
- Corrective actions taken

The Industrial User shall notify the following City agencies in the following order until contact is made:

1. Industrial Pretreatment Program (303)-335-4785
2. Wastewater Treatment Plant (303) 335-4784
3. Deputy Director of Utilities (303) 335-4610
4. After Hours Emergency Line (303) 441-4444

Within five (5) days following an accidental discharge, the Industrial User shall submit to the City a detailed written report describing the cause of the discharge and the measures to be taken by the industrial user to prevent similar future occurrences. Such notification shall not relieve the Industrial User of any expense, loss, damage, or liability which may be incurred as a result of damage to the POTW, fish kills, or any other damage to persons or property, nor shall such notification relieve the Industrial User of any fines, civil penalties, or other liability which may be imposed by this chapter or other applicable law.

Notice to Employees

The Industrial User shall ensure that all employees who may cause or suffer accidental or other non-compliance discharge are advised of emergency notification procedures. At a minimum, a notice shall be permanently posted on the Industrial User's bulletin board or comparable prominent place advising employees who to call in the event of an accidental discharge.
